ENTRY DEADLINE AND JUDGING

1. Entries must be received at the Kitsap Building Association office by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, **October 18**, 2017. You can email the entire entry to: Teresa Taylor at **Teresa@KitsapBuilds.com**, or mail your entry to: Kitsap Building Association, 5251 Auto Center Way, Bremerton, WA 98312. Entries that arrive after the designated date and time may not be accepted. THIS DEADLINE IS FIRM!
2. All entries must follow the entry rules as set forth in this REX Entry Application packet. This includes submitting no more than the specific number of photos allowed by category, providing an accurate "project completion date" consistent with the REX timeframe, and adherence to all other requirements set forth in this REX Entry Application.
3. Judging will take place shortly after the designation entry deadline. A panel of professionals from various fields of expertise will judge all entries. Judges will not know the company names of entered projects.
4. Entries will be judged in accordance with the following criteria:
 - Use of appropriate building material
 - Quality of workmanship
 - Special or unique design solutions
 - Aesthetic consideration, including the cost to value

Winners will be announced on November 15 at the REX Awards cocktail reception. Register for the awards reception with your payment today!

PROJECT DESCRIPTION GUIDE

Keep this information. Do not submit these last two pages.

Please use the guideline below to complete your *required one-page* project summary for your REX entry. One summary is required for each entry. IMPORTANT: If you are submitting multiple entries, DO NOT use “boiler plate” language, or repeated phrases from one entry’s Project Description to another. Doing this creates a link between all your entries and will allow the judges to determine which projects were submitted by the same remodeler. This is a “blind” judging and anonymity is important. Below is a general format for your one-page summary. Following this guideline is helpful to ensure you cover the major points. You do not need to treat each section as a question. Within each section is information about how to reply. Again, this is a guide and not a survey. Your write-up needs to give the judges enough information to determine if your project, compared to all others, is worthy of a Remodeling EXCELLENCE award.

I. WHAT WAS THE MAIN OBJECTIVE OF THE REMODEL?

A. What did the customer want from the remodel?

(e.g.; more living space, upgraded/modern look, aging in place benefits, etc.)

B. If there was an emphasis on sustainability (GREEN), or other earth friendly initiatives with this project be sure to talk about that and how it impacted the project overall.

C. What were you, as a builder, trying to achieve with the remodel, and did you?

II. CREATIVE AND EFFICIENT USE OF SPACE

Describe how space played a role in the remodel. Please provide square footage before and after (Understanding the space limitations can be important to the judges.)

III. SPECIAL OR UNIQUE DESIGN SOLUTIONS

A. What obstacles did you face? Explain

B. Did you make changes because of problems that arose during construction? Explain

C. If you did make changes during the process, what were your solutions? Explain

IV: USE OF APPROPRIATE BUILDING MATERIALS

Describe the type and quality of materials used. If materials were limited due to budget constraints explain how you met your personal standards while maintaining budget and customer expectations. If this project included an emphasis on sustainability or other earth friendly approaches, take the time to describe the materials related to that effort.

V: QUALITY OF WORKMANSHIP

It's time to pump yourself up and let the judges see the quality of your work. Things to consider in this section of your write-up include: Why did you select this project to submit? What about it does a good job of representing you and your work ethic? If there is one element of the project that you are most proud of, what is it and why?

VI. COST/VALUE

If you are in a category that has a price range, please use the choices in your summary to describe where within the price range this project belongs: Low Middle High. If you are in a category without a price range, please let the judges know in some manner the cost of this project. The judges need a way to measure if this was a good value and sharing with them the total cost is helpful. REMEMBER: You are to select a category that reflects the most proper price range based on all the elements shown in your photos and description.

If the homeowner purchased appliances outside of the contract for the work you did for them, you are expected to place the project in a category that reflects those costs as well; not simply what you were paid to complete the job.

-- Please Note --

Your photos must match the project description. Please save each photo you submit with a file name that corresponds with your one-page project description. For example, "Smith Before Kitchen 1" should be indicated in your summary and you should have a "Smith After Kitchen 1" noted in the summary and a photo from the same angle (if possible) to view the transformation. This makes it easier to prepare the best presentation for the judges. More information on the photo requirements follows.

PROJECT PHOTO SUBMITTAL GUIDE

Photos of your project are extremely important to the REX Awards judges. Carefully review all your "before and after" photos paying attention to matching as many as possible in order to really depict the transformation of the project. It is not required that each view have a before and after angle, but the more you can show, the better the "story" of your project can be followed by the judges. Because compiling the REX Awards is a time consuming process, it is important that photos submitted are carefully selected by the applicant company. Using the list below, you must keep the number of photos you submit to the limits described below.

--Submitting more photos than allowed will disqualify your entry--

All project category entries are limited to 10 photos with the following exceptions:

- Residential Additions in all the categories up to \$175,000 are allowed a maximum of 12 photos and must include one exterior before and one exterior after shot.
- Residential Additions Over \$175,000 are allowed a maximum of 14 photos and must include one exterior before and one exterior after shot.
- Residential Whole House (all price categories) are allowed a maximum of 14 photos. (If the project includes any extension/addition to the home, one exterior before and one exterior after shot is required.)
- Commercial Over \$250,000 are allowed 14 photos.

All photos must be saved with file names that correspond to the project description or to the major elements of the project. Please review all the previous information in this packet about photos and naming of the saved shots.

NOTE: ANY PROJECT WITH PHOTOS THAT ARE NOT CAREFULLY SAVED AND NAMED IN A MANNER EASILY REFERENCED, WILL BE JUDGED ON THE FEWEST NUMBER OF PHOTOS NECESSARY TO SHOW THE PROJECT (NOTE THAT THIS MAY BE FEWER THAN 10 PHOTOS).
