You will also be provided with valuable insights on how L&I views lead related work, along with other resources to help your company stay in compliance Cost: \$275 for Members, \$375 for non-members
Thursday February 4 8am-5pm at the HBA	Business Management for Building Professionals (register with BIAW) Learn the management skills that give industry leaders the edge. CPR & First Aid Training *Register with HBA 360-479-5778, www.kitsaphba.com*
The Washington State Industrial Safety & Health Act (WISHA) includes the requirement that a person holding valid certificate of First Aid Training be present or available at all work sites. Additionally, there are increasingly more contractors that require their subs to prove their employees have first aid certifications. All persons taking this class will be certified for two years, and this class qualifies for recertification of existing card holders
Cost: \$50 for Members, \$60 for non-members

Certified Erosion & Sediment Control Lead-CESCL (register with BIAW)
Ecology requires that all sites disturbing over an acre must have a Certified Erosion and Sediment Control Lead (CESCL). Take this class to learn how to inspect, install, and manage stormwater controls on your site. Because Ecology requires CESCL to be on-call at all times, most companies will need more than one employee trained as a CESCL
Cost: \$250 for Members, \$325 for non-members

CESCL Recertification (register with BIAW)
CESCL certifications must be renewed every 3 years with a one-day class. Designed for residential builders, this class will answer the most-asked builder questions, including what BMP's perform best on construction sites, how to keep them working, what red flags signal erosion problems, and how to effectively work with local and state inspectors.
Cost: \$175 for Members, \$250 for non-members
